ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for construction of the Reconstruction of Back Bay Infrastructure Project – Phase Four for the Town of Templeton, Massachusetts, will be received at the Board of Selectmen, 690 Patriots Road, Templeton, Massachusetts, 01468 until 12:00 p.m. prevailing time, on February 16, 2012, at which time and place said bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The scope of work includes construction of approximately 2,115 linear feet of water main and approximately 1,500 linear feet of drainage pipe, sidewalks, curbing, and road related improvements. The estimated project cost is \$525,000.00. Contract duration is 120 consecutive days.

Funding for this project is provided by a grant from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Housing and Community Development under the Community Development Block Grant Program.

Bid Security is required in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid. The selected contractor shall furnish a performance bond and a payment bond in amount at least equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price. Prequalification of contractors is required under provisions of Section 34 of Chapter 90 and in accordance with 720 CMR 5.00. Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and Women's Business Enterprise (WBE) policies of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the Town of Templeton are applicable to this Contract. The "Fair Share" construction goal for this project is a minimum of 7.4% percent participation and 4% WBE participation by state-certified MBEs and WBEs.

All bids for this project are subject to applicable bidding laws of Massachusetts, including General Laws Chapter 30, Section 39M as amended. This project is subject to Title IV of Civil Rights Act of 1964, Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968, and Equal Employment Opportunity.

Minimum Wage Rates as determined by the Commissioner of the Division of Occupational Safety of the Executive Office of Labor and Workforce Development under the provisions of the Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 149, Section 26 to 27D, as amended or as determined by the U.S. Department of Labor under the Davis-Bacon and related Acts (whichever is higher), apply to this project.

The Bidder agrees that this bid shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of 30 working days, Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays excluded after the opening of bids.
