Town Administrator Report~ Bob spoke about the current severe weather policy and the need for clarification on it. Ms. Farrell made a motion to approve the Inclement Severe Weather Policy as presented. Mr. Columbus seconded the motion. **The vote was 5 yes.** Bob stated that he had information that the \$85,000.00 for the playground from the state was cut. Mr. Robinson stated that he also had a call from Tyler Wolanin at Senator Gobi's office that the money was cut. The Board decided on a date for the meeting to discuss the budget, which will be on March 2, at 7 p.m.

Contract for Triennial Revaluation~Assessors ~ Mr. Columbus made a motion to approve the state contract with Vision Government Solutions, Inc. for the Triennial Revaluation for the Board of Assessors not to exceed \$45,000.00 Ms. Farrell seconded the motion. **The vote was 5 yes.**

6:45 p.m.~ Cable Hearing~ Steve Castle, Chairman of the Cable Commission, presented information regarding the negotiations with Comcast for a Cable Contract that needs to be renewed. After discussion, Mr. Morrison made a motion to allow the Cable Commission to hire Attorney Solomon to negotiate the cable contract. Ms. Farrell seconded the motion. **The vote was 5 yes.**

Ms. Farrell made a motion to close the public hearing and return to open session. Ms. Haley Brooks seconded the motion. **The vote was 5 yes.**

Ms. Haley Brooks made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Morrison seconded the motion. **The vote was 5 yes.**
