In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the several precincts of the Town of Templeton, County of Worcester, qualified to vote in Town elections to meet at the following location, designated and appointed by the Selectman, to wit:

On Monday, the Tenth day of December next, from 11:00 o'clock A.M. to 7:00 o'clock P.M. to bring in their votes to the Election Officers on one ballot as follows:

Question 1 Shall the Town of Templeton be allowed to exempt from the provisions of Propostion 2 ½, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the purchase of a new pumper and equipment located in Templeton Center. The cost of the debt exclusion for this truck and equipment would be Two-Hundred Forty Thousand and No Cents(240,000.00).
