WARRANT FOR SPECIAL TOWN MEETING  
DECEMBER 1, 1992  
COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

WORCESTER, ss.

To either of the constables of the Town of Templeton in said County.

GREETING:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the several precincts of the Town of Templeton, County of Worcester, qualified to vote in elections and town affairs to meet in the Narragansett Regional High School, South Main Street, Baldwinville, on December 1, 1992 at 7:00 P.M., then and there to act on the following articles:

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to Transfer from Available Funds a sum of money for the Interest on Temporary Borrowing in Anticipation of State Reimbursement for State approved roadway projects under the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws. Chapter 90, and funded in accordance with Chapter 33 of the Acts of 1991; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded, the Town voted to transfer from the property revaluation account the sum of Three Thousand, Thirty Two Dollars and Eighty-Five cents (\$3,032.85) for the interest on temporary borrowing in anticipation of State Reimbursement for State approved roadway projects under the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 90, and funded in accordance with Chapter 33 of the Acts of 1991.

Passed

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Available Funds a sum of money for the Assessors Expenses Account to fund a part-time clerk for the Board of Assessors; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded, the Town voted to transfer the sum of Nine Hundred Fifteen Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$915.70) from the property revaluation account to the assessors expenses account to fund a part-time clerk for the Assessors.

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to Transfer from Available Funds a sum of money to update the Tax Maps, and further to authorize the Board of Assessors to take all actions necessary to carry out the purposes of this article; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded, the Town voted to appropriate from the stabilization fund the sum of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000) to update the tax maps, and further to authorize the Board of Assessors to take all actions necessary to carry out the purposes of this article.

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to Transfer from Available Funds a sum of money to supplement the Water Department Expenses Account for implementation of the pilot Corrosion Control Program at the Sawyer Street, East Templeton Well; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded, the Town voted to transfer the sum of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000) from the Highway Department Expenses account to the Water Department expenses account for the implementation of the Pilot Corrosion Control program at the Sawyer Street, East Templeton well.
