WARRANT FOR SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
MAY 12, 1993
COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

WORCESTER, ss.

To either of the constable of the Town of Templeton in said
County.

GREETINGS:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the several precincts of the Town of Templeton, County of Worcester, qualified to vote in elections and town affairs to meet in the Narragansett Regional High School, South Main Street, Baldwinville, on May 12, 1993 at 8:00 P.M., then and there to act on the following articles:

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate and transfer a sum of money from the Worcester County Dog Fund receipts to the Boyton Library Expense Account; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to appropriate and transfer the sum of Eight Hundred Forty-three Dollars and Thirty-five Cents (\$843.35) from the Worcester County Dog Fund receipts to the Boynton Library Account.
Passed unanimously

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Selectmen's Expense Account to the Town Travel Expense Account; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to transfer the sum of One Hundred Eighty-six Dollars (\$186.00) from the Selectmen's Expense Account to the Town Travel Expense Account.
Passed unanimously

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate and transfer a sum of money from the Insurance Recoveries Receipts Reserved for Appropriation Account to the Highway Department Town Barn Fire Expenses account to offset emergency expenses due to the Highway Barn Fire; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to appropriate and transfer the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) from the Insurance Recoveries Receipts Reserved for Appropriation Account to the Highway Department Town Barn Fire Expenses account

to offset emergency expenses due to the Highway Barn Fire.
Passed unanimously

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate or borrow under the provisions of Chapter 44, or otherwise, the sum of \$164,360 to be used for Highway purposes under Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 90, Section 34, Clause 2(a); said monies being the Town's second allocation of funds pursuant to Chapter 33 of the Acts of 1991, apportioned by the State Department of Public Works and Department of Revenue as available funds for appropriation by the Town; reimbursement of expenditures to the Town will be made following receipt of appropriate documentation that costs for the approved project(s) have been incurred; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to borrow under the provisions of Chapter 44, or otherwise, the sum of \$164,360 to be used for Highway purposes under Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 90, Section 34, Clause 2(a); said monies being the Town's second allocation of funds pursuant to Chapter 33 of the Acts of 1991, apportioned by the State Department of Public Works and Department of Revenue as available funds for appropriation by the Town; reimbursement of expenditures to the Town will be made following receipt of appropriate documentation that costs for the approved project(s) have been incurred.

Passed unanimously

Article 5. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Available Funds a sum of money to supplement the Police Department Expenses Account for FY'93; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to transfer from the Group Insurance Account the sum of Eleven Thousand, Six Hundred Five Dollars (\$11,605.00) to supplement the Police Department Expenses Account for FY'93.

Passed unanimously

Article 6. To see if the Town will Vote to transfer from Available Funds a sum of money to supplement the Special Reserve Account (Adivisory Board) for FY'93; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to transfer from the following accounts the amounts of money specified to a total sum of Ten Thousand, Four Hundred Sixty-Seven Dollars and fifty-five cents (\$10,467.55) to supplement the Special Reserve Account (Advisory Board) for FY'93.
