WARRANT FOR SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
MAY 10, 1994
COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

WORCESTER, ss.

To either of the constables of the Town of Templeton in said County.

GREETING:

In the Name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the several precincts of the Town of Templeton, County of Worcester, qualified to vote in elections and town affairs to meet in the Narragansett Regional High School, 464 Baldwinville Road, Baldwinville, on May 10, 1994 at 8:00 p.m. then and there to act on the following articles:

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Worcester County Dog Fund receipts to the Boynton Public Library Expense Account; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to transfer Seven Hundred Seventy-seven Dollars and Eighty-five cents (\$777.85) from the Worcester County Dog Fund receipts to the Boynton Public Library Expense Account.

Article 2. To see if the Town will appropriate a sum of money by borrowing to design and construct an Aeration System for the purification of the water from the Otter River well located on Willow Street, Otter River, and to authorize the Treasurer, with the approval of the Board of Selectmen, to issue any Bonds or Notes that may be necessary for the purpose; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to appropriate and borrow \$300,000.00 for the design and construction of Aeration System for the purification of the water from the Otter River well located on Willow Street, Otter River and to authorize the Treasurer with the approval of the Selectmen, to issue any bonds or notes that may be necessary for the purpose, as authorized by General Laws Chapter 44, s8 (4), or any other general or special law, for a period of not to exceed thirty (30) years, provided that this appropriation and debt authorization be contingent upon passage of a Proposition 2 1/2 debt exclusion referendum under General Laws Chapter 59, s21 (C) k.

Article 3. To see if the Town will appropriate a sum of money by borrowing to install corrosion control equipment on four Town water wells, two on Maple Street, Baldwinville, one well on Sawyer Street, East Templeton, and one well on Willow Street, Otter River, and to authorize the Treasurer, with the approval of the Board of Selectmen, to issue any Bonds or Notes that may be necessary for that purpose; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to appropriate and borrow \$137,800.00 to install Corrosion Control Equipment for four (4) town water wells, two on Maple Street, Baldwinville, one well on Sawyer Street, East Templeton, one well on Willow Street, Otter Rvier and to authorize the Treasurer with the approval of the Selectmen, to issue any bonds or notes that may be necessary for the purposes, as authorized by General Laws, Chapter 44 s8 (4) or any other general or special law, for a period of not ~~or to~~ to exceed thirty (30) years, provided, however, that this appropriation and debt authorization be contingent upon passage of a Proposition 2 1/2 debt exclusion referendum under General Laws Chapter 50 s21 c (k).

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer out of the Town's Group Insurance to the Special Reserve Account (Advisory Board); or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a Substitute Motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to transfer Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) from the Group Insurance Account; Six Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-three Dollars and Forty-seven Cents (\$6,463.47) from the Interest on Temporary Borrowing --Highway Chapter 133 Funds Account; and Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00) from the Rehab Michigan Loader/ Mack Sander Account; to a total sum of Thirty-two Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-three Dollars and Forty-seven Cents (\$32,463.47); to supplement the Special Reserve (Advisory Board) Account for FY94; or to take any other action relative thereto.

And you are hereby directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof in each precinct; namely, at the Post Office in Templeton, the Post Office in East Templeton, the Post Office in Baldwinville, and at Cote's Market in Otter River, and by delivering a copy to each of the Precinct Clerks seven (7) days at least before the time of holding said meeting and by causing notice of the same to be published once in the Gardner News, a newspaper in each County, in the City of Gardner.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this warrant
with your doings thereon at the same time and place of said meeting.
