GREETINGS:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the precincts of the Town of Templeton, County of Worcester, qualified to vote in elections and town affairs to meet in the Board of Selectmen's Office, Town Office Building, 9 Main Street, Otter River, Ma on November 21, 1994 at 7:00 p.m., then and there to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to Raise & Appropriate or transfer from Available Funds a sum of money for a Savin Copy Machine for the Town Office Building in Baldwinville; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded, the Town voted to transfer Four Thousand Three Hundred Forty Nine Dollars (\$4,349.00) from the Sale of Real Estate Account to the Town Office Building Repairs Expense Account.
Passed

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from the Town Vehicle/Machine Maintenance Salary Account a sum of money to the Water Department Salary Account and further to transfer the remaining sum from the Town Vehicle/Machine Maintenance Salary Account to the Highway Salary Account; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded, the Town voted to Transfer from the Town Vehicle/Machine Maintenance Salary Account the sum of Twenty-One Thousand, Nine Hundred Ninety Dollars and Eighty-Two Cents (\$21,990.82) to the Water Department Salary Account and further

to transfer the remaining sum of Seven Thousand, One Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars and Eighteen Cents (\$7,168.18) from the Town Vehicle/Machine Maintenance Salary Account to the Highway Department Salary Account, for a total amount of Twenty-Nine Thousand, One Hundred Fifty Nine Dollars (\$29,159.00).

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to accept Kyle Drive as a public way, under the requirements of the Subdivision Control Laws, in accordance with the layout approved by the Board of Selectmen, the street being shown on a plan on file with the Town Clerk's Office, and to authorize the Board of Selectmen to acquire any necessary easements or fee simple interests through gift, eminent domain, purchase or otherwise; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to accept Kyle Drive, Templeton as a public way, under the requirements of the Subdivision Control Laws, in accordance with the layout approved by the Board of Selectmen, the Street being shown on a plan on file at the Town Clerk's Office, and to authorize the Board of Selectmen to acquire any necessary easements or fee simple interests through gift, eminent domain, purchase or otherwise.
