WARRANT FOR SPECIAL TOWN MEETING  
JUNE 20, 1995  
COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

WORCESTER, ss.

To either of the constables of the Town of Templeton in said County.

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the several precincts of the Town of Templeton, County of Worcester, qualified to vote in elections and town affairs to meet in the Narragansett Regional High School, 464 Baldwinville Road, Baldwinville, on June 20, 1995 at 8:00 p.m. then and there to act on the following articles:

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Selectmen's Office Salaries Account to the Selectmen's Office Expense Account; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to transfer the sum of FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00) from the Selectmen's Office Salaries Account to the Selectmen's Office Expense Account.

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Fire Department Salaries Account to the Fire Department Expense Account; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to transfer a sum of TWELVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$12,000.00) from the Fire Department Salaries Account to the Fire Department Expense Account.

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Police Department Salaries Account to the Police Department Expense Account; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to transfer a sum of FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00) from the Police Department Salaries Account to the Police Department Expense Account.

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Police Department Salaries Account to the Town Vehicle/Machine Maintenance Expense Account, ie; Cruiser maintenance; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to transfer a sum of FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY SEVEN DOLLARS (\$557.00) from the Police Department Salaries Account to the Town Vehicle/Machine Maintenance Expense Account, ie; Cruiser maintenance.

And you are hereby directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof in each precinct, manely, at the Post Office in Templeton, the Post Office in East Templeton, the Post Office in Baldwinville, and at Cote's Market in Otter River, and by delivering a copy to each of the Precinct Clerks seven (7) days at least before the time of holding said meeting and by causing notice of the same to be published once in the Gardner News, a newspaper in each County, in the City of Gardner.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon at the time and place of said meeting.
