GREETINGS:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the precincts of the Town of Templeton, County of Worcester, qualified to vote in elections and town affairs to meet at the Narragansett Regional High School, 464 Baldwinville Road, Baldwinville, Ma. on Tuesday March 14, 1995 at 7:00 p.m., then and there to act on the following articles:

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Tax Anticipation Interest Account to the Assessors Office Salary Account for the additional help hired due to the time frame from the Revaluation Program; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to Transfer the sum of One Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$120.00) from the Tax Anticipation Interest Account to the Assessors Office Salary Account or act in relation thereto.

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from the Cemetery Improvement Fund to the Cemetery Expense Account; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to Transfer the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) from the Cemetery Improvement Fund to the Cemetery Expense Account or act in relation thereto.

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Available Funds a sum of money to repair the Police Station Roof, or to take any other action relative thereto.

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Available Funds a sum of money to drill a test well on property commonly known as "the Gavin Property" off Royalston Road; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to Transfer from the Selectmens Office Salaries Account a sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) to drill a test well or wells on property commonly known as "the Gavin Property" off Royalston Road or act in relation thereto.

Article 5. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Available Funds a sum of money to the Machinery Repair Account to cover anticipated repair expenses; or to take any other action relative thereto.

Article 6. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Available Funds a sum of money to do a survey of the recharge areas for the two (2) Maple Street, Sawyer Street and Willow Street wells as required by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to Transfer from the Selectmens Office Salaries Account a sum of Seven Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00) to survey the recharge areas for the two (2) Maple Street and Sawyer Street wells as required by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts or act in relation thereto.

Article 7. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Available Funds a sum of money to the legal account to cover the cost of unanticipated legal expenses; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to Transfer from the Selectmens Salaries Account to the Legal Account the sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-Two Dollars (\$3,572.00) in order to cover unanticipated expenses involving mediation or act in relation thereto.
