GREETINGS:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby  
directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the precincts of  
the Town of Templeton, County of Worcester, qualified to vote in  
elections and town affairs to meet at the Narragansett Regional  
High School, 464 Baldwinville Road, Baldwinville, MA, on Tuesday  
May 9, 1995 at 8:00 P.M., then and there to act on the following  
articles:

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to Transfer from  
Available Funds a sum of money to the Machinery  
Repair Expense Account; or take any other action  
relative thereto.

No Motion

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to Transfer from  
Available Funds to the Police Expense Account  
a sum of money to cover the Cost of Material  
and Labor to Repair Roof on the Police Station;  
or take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted  
to Transfer from the Snow & Ice Removal Expense  
Account to the Police Expense Account a sum of  
FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00) to cover the  
Cost of Material and Labor to Repair Roof on the  
Police Station.

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to Transfer from Available Funds to the Police Expense Account a sum of money to cover the cost of Material and Labor to make the Police Station Handicap accessible; or take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to Transfer from the Police Salary Account to the Police Expense Account a sum of SEVEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$7,000.00) to cover the cost of Material and Labor to make the Police Station Handicap accessible.

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Available Funds to the Police Expense Account a sum of money to Install a Fire Alarm System in the Police Station; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to transfer from the Snow & Ice Removal Expense Account to the Police Expense Account a sum of THREE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SIXTEEN DOLLARS (\$3,416.00) to Install a Fire Alarm System in the Police Station.

Article 5. To see if the Town will vote to Raise and Appropriate or Transfer from Available Funds a sum of money to operate the Water Department; or to take action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to Raise and Appropriate \$130,000.00 from sewer receipts, and \$56,128.25 from the tax levy, to a total sum of \$186,128.25, for the operating expense of the sewer department for Fiscal Year 1996, to be expended as follows:
