WARRANT FOR SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
SEPTEMBER 28, 1995
COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

WORCESTER, ss.

To either of the Constables of the Town of Templeton in said County.

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the precincts of the Town of Templeton, County of Worcester, qualified to vote in elections and town affairs to meet at the Narragansett Regional High School, 464 Baldwinville Road, Baldwinville, MA, on Thursday, September 28, 1995 at 7:00 p.m., then and there to act on the following articles:

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to Raise and Appropriate or Transfer from Available Funds a sum of money to pay a Recreation Commission Expense for the FY '95 unpaid bill; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to Transfer from the Redistricting Notice to Voters Account the sum of One Hundred Ninety-Four Dollars (\$194.00) to pay a Recreation Commission Expense for FY '95 unpaid bill.

Passed

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to Raise and Appropriate or Transfer from the Available Funds a sum of money to pay a FY '95 unpaid bill; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to Transfer from the Redistricting Notice to Voters Account the sum of One Hundred Thirty-Six Dollars and Sixty-Eight Cents (\$136.68) to pay a FY '95 unpaid bill.

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to Raise and Appropriate or Transfer from Available Funds a sum of money to the Selectmen's Salaries Account; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to Transfer from the following accounts the sum of Seven Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00) to the Selectmen's Office Salaries Account:

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to Raise and Appropriate or Transfer from Available Funds a sum of money to Refurbish a 1982 GMC, 1 Ton Dump Truck; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to Transfer from the Stabilization Fund the sum of Two Thousand, Two Hundred Dollars (\$2,200.00) to Refurbish a 1982 GMC, 1 Ton Dump Truck.

Article 5. To see if the Town will vote to Raise and Appropriate or Transfer from Available Funds a sum of money to repair a 1975 Catch Basin Truck; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to Transfer from the following accounts the sum of Three Thousand Thirty Dollars (\$3,030.00) to repair a 1975 Catch Basin Truck:

Article 6. To see if the Town will vote to revise the Assessment for the Fiscal Year 1996 for the Montachusett Regional Vocational Technical School District; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to Transfer from the Insurance Recoveries-Highway Barn Fire (Contents) Account the sum of One Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-Eight Dollars (\$1,898.00) to revise the Assessment for the Fiscal Year 1996 for the Montachusett Regional Vocation Technical School District.

Article 7. To see if the Town will vote to rescind and revote Article 29 of the May 9, 1995 Annual Town Meeting which read: To see if the Town will vote to Raise and Appropriate or Transfer from Available Funds, or Borrow under the Provision of Chapter 44, or otherwise, a sum of money to be used for Highway purposes under 34 (2) (a), said Funds being the Town's First Allocation of Funds pursuant to the 1994 Transportation and Bond Bill Apportioned by the State Department of Highways and Department of Revenue as Available Funds for Appropriate by the Town. Reimbursements of Expenditures to the Town will be made following Receipt of Appropriate Documentation that costs for the Approved Project have been incurred, or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to rescind the vote taken under Article 29 at the Annual Town Meeting held on May 9, 1995, at which time the sum of Two Hundred Sixty-Eight Thousand, Five Hundred Eighty-One Dollars (\$268,581.00) was voted for the purposes as set fourth in said Article and move that the Selectmen borrow under the Provision of Chapter 44, or otherwise, a sum of Two Hundred Sixty-Nine Thousand, Five Hundred Eighty-One Dollars (\$269,581.00) to be used for Highway Purposes under 34 (2) (a) said Funds being the Town's First Allocation of Funds pursuant to the 1994 Transportation and Bond Bill Apportioned by the State Department of Highways and Department of Revenue as Available Funds for Appropriation by the Town. Reimbursements of Expenditures to the Town will be made following Receipt of Appropriate Documentation that costs for the Approved Project have been incurred.

- Article 8. To see if the Town will vote to accept April Circle as a public way, under the requirements of the Subdivision Control Laws, in accordance with the layout approved by the Board of Selectmen, the street being shown on a plan on file with the Town Clerk's Office, and to authorize the Board of Selectmen to acquire any necessary easements or fee simple interest through gift, eminent domain, purchase or otherwise, or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to accept April Circle as a public way, under the requirements of the Subdivision Control Laws, in accordance with the layout approved by the Board of Selectmen, the street being shown on a plan on file with the Town Clerk's Office, and to authorize the Board of Selectmen to acquire any necessary easements or fee simple interest through gift, eminent domain, purchase or otherwise.

- Article 9. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from the Snow & Ice Removal Account to a Snow and Ice Private Roads Removal Account; or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to transfer the sum of Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) from the Snow & Ice Removal Account to a Snow & Ice Private Roads Removal Account.
